It's amazing what you can learn by actively listening to someone's story. When visiting any healthcare professional, it's important for patients to feel that their voices are heard and their concerns are validated. While some doctors routinely dismiss questions or information a patient provides, Dr. Tiyaishi Choudhury believes that active listening and patient education is the cornerstone of her medical practice philosophy. As the newest member of the Rocky Creek Family Medicine (RCFM) team in Missouri City, Texas, Dr. Choudhury engages and communicates with patients on a personal level, gleaned vital bits of information about their lifestyles and habits to gain a clearer picture of their current health status. Educating them on ways to attain optimal health goals—primarily

without pharmaceuticals—is her preferred method of care.

RCFM is an established family practice of three experienced, board-certified female physicians led by Dr. Deirdre McMullen. “Dr. McMullen has such a personalized quality with her patients,” Dr. Choudhury explains. “I was impressed with her ability to seamlessly develop relationships with them, ultimately leading me to choose RCFM as my new ‘home’ for practicing medicine.” She joined RCFM almost two years ago and has never looked back. She enjoys facilitating an open dialogue with her patients and creating the development of individually-tailored treatment plans based on their medical needs and goals. “I take time to listen as we work together toward solutions,” she says. “Patients definitely

Dr. Choudhury decided she wanted to be a physician when she was a young girl. Being raised in a small town allowed her to recognize how much her father, a cardiologist, loved taking care of his patients. She remembers the genuine, caring conversations and friendly hugs between her father and his patients, especially when they were seen in town. She noticed their trust in him as a friend and a doctor and wanted the same authentic interaction
